### Tackle Root Causes of Hunger: Ruto Urges Africa

is Excellency President William Ruto, accompanied by the Cabinet Secretary for the Ministry of Investments, Trade and Industry Hon. Salim Mvurya and Principal Secretary, SDI Dr. Juma Mukhwana attended a High- level political session of the World Without Hunger Conference in Addis Ababa from 5th to 7th November 2024.

In His remarks, President Ruto emphasized the urgent need for African countries to double their efforts in combating hunger and building sound food security.

He pointed out that the solution towards food insecurity in the continent lay in taking bold and collective initiatives to tackle the root causes. "I wish to call for upscaling of investment in agricultural communities, sustainable production practices, and resilient food systems" said President Ruto.

He further outlined key policies and measures that Kenya has put towards ending Hunger and ensuring food security. These include, issuance of state subsidized fertilizer to farmers, promotion of value addition and industrialization and strengthening of trade through economic cooperation among others.
